Recyclables must be divided into 2 categories, **Category I (Non-Paper Recyclables)** and **Category II (Paper Recyclables)** and will be picked up on an alternating weekly schedule, along with your regular trash collection. Please refer to the following calendar denoting which category is to be collected each week.

Category I: Non-Paper Recyclables (collected during weeks indicated in red)

ACCEPTABLE:

- Aluminum, steel, and tin cans
- Glass from food & beverage containers, all colors acceptable

**All items listed in this category may be commingled within your recycling bin*

EXCLUDED:

- No ceramics, light bulbs, plate glass, or foam products
- Container lids must be removed & discarded

- Plastic containers marked #1 - #7 on the bottom
- Opaque jugs (milk, cider, water, etc.)
ie: soda & laundry detergent bottles

PREPARATION:

- All recyclables should be rinsed free of residue. Labels are acceptable and may remain on all containers.
- The crushing of milk jugs and cans is desirable, but not mandatory. Glass should be unbroken.
- Place recyclables loose (not bagged) in a rigid recycling bin.

Category II: Paper Recyclables (collected during weeks indicated in black)

ACCEPTABLE:

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Corrugated cardboard
- Mixed and/or shredded office paper
- Copy paper
- Phone books
- Drawing paper
- Note pads
- Paperback Books
- Boxboard: cereal boxes, etc. (free of plastic & wax lining)
- Junk mail (plastic window okay)

**All items listed in this category may be commingled within your recycling bin*

EXCLUDED:

- No plastic coated papers
- No plastics
- No paper plates, cups, or napkins
- No carbon paper
- No waxed corrugated paper
- No foil paper
- No tissue

PREPARATION:

- Corrugated cardboard should be flattened and stacked, not to exceed 2' x 2' x 2'.
- Do not bundle paper recyclables. Place loosely stacked in paper bags (no plastic) or in a rigid recycling bin.

* Bins used for recyclables may not exceed 35 gallons in capacity or 50 lbs in weight, and should be clearly marked for recycling .



Curbside Trash Collection

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Although Pinard Waste Systems will typically make collections at approximately the same time each week, occasionally circumstances occur causing us to alter our schedule, resulting in earlier collections. In order to avoid missing your collection, **materials must be placed at curbside by 6:30 am** on your scheduled collection day. The appropriate week's recyclables should also be placed curbside at this time, in a separate container from household trash, and clearly marked for recycling.
- Maximum size per container: 35 gallons- Larger containers may be utilized provided the contents are bagged within the receptacle.
- Maximum weight per container: 50 pounds
- Maximum number of containers: no limit for normal, weekly generated household waste. However, rates are based on a per family, per dwelling basis.

MATERIALS REQUIRING SPECIAL HANDLING

- Special arrangements and surcharges are required for any materials that require special handling, which are not included with the weekly collection. These items include:
 - bulky / heavy items of any type
 - liquid waste of any type
 - construction / demolition materials
 - tires
 - fluorescent light bulbs
 - hazardous / toxic substances
 - ashes
 - electronics (tv's, stereos, monitors, etc.)
- ** **Sharp objects** (needles, razor blades, broken glass, etc.): Pinard Waste Systems will collect these items along with your scheduled collection. However, per New Hampshire rule, they must be placed in a rigid, puncture-resistant, sealed container, such as a laundry detergent bottle, and placed in with the regular trash, not the recycling. **
- NH RSA 149-M:15 and 16 mandate that leaf and yard waste must be composted and may not be disposed of in the waste stream. In order to comply with this statute, the following items must also be handled separately, and therefore also require special arrangements and surcharges:
 - leaves
 - lawn rakings
 - brush

HOLIDAYS

- Pinard Waste Systems strives to minimize the inconvenience to our customers caused by collection delays. Therefore, you can expect us to be operating on schedule on most holidays. The following holidays are the only exceptions:
 - New Year's Day
 - 4th of July
 - Thanksgiving
 - Memorial Day
 - Labor Day
 - Christmas Day
- Observed holidays impact trash collection in the following manner:
Within the holiday week, trash collection will occur on schedule on the days preceding the holiday. Collections scheduled for the holiday, as well as the remainder of the week will be delayed one day.
- ** For example, *Thanksgiving falls on a Thursday. Customers with scheduled collections Monday through Wednesday of that week will not be affected. Thursday's collections will occur on Friday, and Friday's collections will occur on Saturday.* **
